In the second week of August we had a Vacation Bible School with the desire to share the gospel with the children. About 35 children attended throughout the week and learned about the beatitudes of Jesus in

Matthew chapter 5.

At the end of VBS, we invited the parents to hear the gospel. There were about 30 adults present. There were moments in which I saw the Lord work in the hearts of the children and adults. Some of the parents and children expressed interest in coming to church services. We hope, in the Lord, that it will be so.



Additionally, we had the blessing of sending off two young people from the church who moved to the city of Monterrey to attend Universidad Cristiana de las Américas to prepare themselves to serve the Lord. I am so happy to see more young people rising to the work of ministry. Jael Fajardo

and Dana Arceo will spend the next 4 years at UCLA and our desire is that they will return to serve in Chetumal. These young people are the result of the work of God in Chetumal. Both trusted in the gospel when I started the church and I have been leading them in discipleship.



We ended the month with difficult news. One early morning, thieves came into where our church meets and they stole a TV that we had just purchased, the speaker we use for music in services and the water tank. We let the appropriate authorities know, but they did not catch the thieves. They came through a window and broke the metal bars. The losses were only material, and thank the Lord they did not take the chairs, but they did take the valuable items. We are trusting in God. I am considering moving locations, but I would have to wait for our lease to end and it is difficult to find another similar place for the church.

- Pray for the two young people who left for Bible college to prepare for ministry.
- Pray for provision for the item that were stolen, since they were necessities for our singing and music.
