Pastor Manuel says: "Due to local political activities I could not enter Morete for Bible studies, and instead, I traveled to Quito. I was invited to preach at the 11th anniversary of the church there. Despite not entering Morete, we continue working with them through video calls. We continue to train Sunday School teachers and have prayer times with the church."

THE WORK IN SHELL

He reports, "Every three months we hold a children's evangelistic fair, in which the children enjoy the rewards of their efforts. They earn points by memorizing verses, doing their homework, arriving on time, and bringing a Bible. They exchange points for toys, clothes, candy or shoes. This fair is highly anticipated by the children and even the parents come to see their children at the fair."

Pastor Manuel continues to visit and disciple families. One recent believer, Tayak, is beginning a Bible discipleship class with him.

The church enjoyed a family retreat with other Baptist churches of Morete and San Juan Calderon at a camp.

Regarding the church construction in Shell, Pastor Macancela tells us. "We were blessed to receive the donation of 50 meters of ceramic tile for the floor of the children's classroom, kitchen, and bathrooms. I am personally laying the tiles on the floors, and it will be finished soon. The Kids Club continues to grow, and we will soon have our youth meeting there."
