A Tribute to Caleb and BEME's Beginning

On Sunday morning, December 8, 2024, Rev. Caleb Counterman, 48, was in a single car accident on his way to church and was ushered into the presence of the Lord. Let me tell you why I'm starting the letter this way. About 27 years ago, Caleb took a group of teens from Anchor Baptist Church of Millersville, MD on a trip to Peru to see first hand what missions are about. While there, they met and became very impressed with a national pastor named Joel Gamboa. Joel later became the first



Latin to receive support from what is now, *BEME-LA*.

From that church start came two other churches and from one of those two came another church. Many of you have seen pictures of this in our presentation. Joel is on the left, Caleb is in the middle, and I am on the right.

The teens from that mission trip reported to their church. Testimonies, anecdotes, and songs filled the evening. One of our girls, Christie, sang "Here Am I Lord, Send Me" in Spanish. There wasn't a dry eye in the place as hearts were touched with the desire for gospel missions. From this beginning came other trips to the field, offerings for buildings, and a determination to start several churches in Peru and Colombia. This church allowed me to go to the field to develop the mission into what it is today. Caleb accompanied me on many of the trips, and as he

became pastor of Faith Baptist Church in Morris, IL, that church yoked with many other ministries to start over 80 churches in eight countries in Latin America. His vision, drive, and investment into people and the larger cause of Christ's gospel through missions, marked his passion for the Lord. I have truly lost a yokefellow in the gospel, an investor in people for eternity, and my first-born son. Our lives have been shaken to the core, but the Foundation and Rock, Jesus Christ, is sure. The mission has been wounded, but the Healer is present. We are thankful for the vision and giving spirit of Caleb and his foundational role in the start of Baptist Evangelistic Ministry Endeavors – Latin America. "A group of brothers are being discipled each week in a personal way in their homes. They are learning how to live lives that please the Lord and how to serve Him. Many have become members of the church. Others are in the process of becoming members and following in baptism."

- **Love generously:** Now is the perfect time to show the extravagant love of God to others. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son..." John 3:16. We praise God for the thousands of souls that our national church starters have shared the gospel with this past year. Let's show the love of Christ in our part of the world.
- **Give yourself:** Listen carefully, show genuine appreciation, verbally praise those around you. Give yourself sacrificially as an encouragement and testimony of the many who work in foreign fields tirelessly for God's glory.
- **Offer hope:** There is an anticipated hope in the coming year, as we think of the great potential of expansion in Latin America. New opportunities, new church starts, expanded building programs, increased giving to the mission, answered prayers... all to the glory of God! "That's what the kids in the children's ministry are learning. It is beautiful to tell them that they have God on their side and that He never leaves them. They can trust in Him and talk to Him through prayer when they feel alone. One of our girls, after leaving her class, when she saw that her dad was very worried about his work, said to him: 'Daddy, today we learned that we must leave all our worries in God's hands', and she ended by saying: 'leave all your worries in God's

hands and trust that He will help'."

Pastor Niño shares: "The Lord tells us as a family and church we will go through difficult times. God has allowed us to see His faithfulness and to understand His purposes.
