Continued Growth with More New Church Starts!

In Guaynabo, a village in Carolina, Puerto Rico, a new church is beginning with Brother Dwayne Daniels. He is studying at the Calvary Baptist Bible College in Carolina, PR. He is to be married in June. Puerto Rico is a new mission area for BEME. Pray for this ministry to grow strong in the Lord.





A second new church start will be in the coastal region of Huanchaco, **Peru** - under the pastoral leadership of Josue Rodriguez. Brother Rodriguez trained at the Baptist Seminary of Peru in Trujillo. He is also a talented musician, which will help this new church start. Pray for Josue, Louisa, and their daughter Ada.

In the town of Mairana, in central **Bolivia** - Pastor Glenn Sandoval, an experienced servant of the Lord, will be starting a new church. Pastor Sandoval started two other churches in Bolivia. Both churches have now flourished for over ten years. He and his wife have several grown children that have assisted them in their missionary outreach.

The fourth church start is in **<u>Argentina</u>**. It will be BEME's first church in this country. Pastor Lukas Gonzalez comes to us as a new church starter with experience. He was trained at the Baptist Bible Seminary in Rosario, Argentina, and was ordained as a Baptist pastor in 2023. Join us in welcoming Pastor Lukas, Julieta, and son Kalel.

A fifth new church starter is Yonathan Garcia in Rivera, **<u>Uruguay</u>** who sends us this word: "We are planting a new church in Rivera on the border with Santana do Livramento, Brazil. We thank God that we did not arrive here alone. A group of brothers from the Nuevo Helvecia church, accompanied by Pastor Andres Ramirez, joined us to begin cleaning up and making some improvements in the place where we will be living and starting the **First Fundamental Baptist Church of Rivera**.



I thank God for a brother who donated a speaker for the church and also a sister who donated 16 chairs to start the meetings. Without a doubt, God is faithful. Before leaving Nueva Helvecia, we had an activity with the young people, a special day for them where we shared songs, games, and an exposition of the word of God. Please continue praying for them. It is wonderful to see how, since we arrived in Uruguay, He has supported us, opening doors and providing for every need.

I thank God for the churches that faithfully support us with their prayers and supporting contributions. Without a doubt, God uses his people greatly, and this allows us to do the work freely. Pastor Ramirez shares with us: "We are doing well by the grace of God, continuing to bring the gospel to the lost in Nueva Helvecia and Juan Lacaze. We also thank the Lord for the brothers in the church who are getting involved and who go out to share the gospel. In Nueva Helvecia, there were three professions of faith: Franklin, Beatriz, and María Inés. On March 9th, we celebrated the anniversary of the Nueva Helvecia church. We were joined by a group of brothers who came from Mexico two days before to evangelize and invite people to this event. We ask for your prayers that God works and that souls may be saved as a result of this meeting. We also ask for your prayers because we are getting permits to begin building the foundation of what will be our church building, and this takes time.
